Nata's Story

My mom and I did everything together. She gave me a wonderful upbringing and education. We became the closest, dearest, and best friends. I always appreciated everything she did for me. Unexpectedly, she fell ill and died shortly thereafter. This tragedy broke my heart.



At this difficult time of my life, when the pain was so unspeakable, my boyfriend became my comfort and support. We dated for a year as dear friends. I sought understanding, compassion, warmth, and love. At this vulnerable time, I gave into temptation and crossed the boundaries. We started an intimate relationship.

After a little while I began to suspect pregnancy. It happened at such an inappropriate time. We were not ready for it. Whereas I doubted my choice, my boyfriend said a categorical 'no' to the baby.

I went for a pregnancy test to MTU. 'Positive' cut my heart even deeper. During counseling I learned how precious was the life inside of me - it already had a heartbeat. I left all in tears with a more broken heart than before. I faced one of the most difficult decisions in my life.

I took time to think through all the facts and options and agreed with my counselor - my baby was worth it.

Thank you for the much needed advice. I love my baby and look forward to its birth.
